1. 格式

全文文章用 A4 大小的紙張，每頁上下緣各留 2.5 公分及左右兩側各留 2.5 公分，文章不分欄，打字不可參差不齊，除段落之標明，其餘文字全部採用新細明體。

全文文章包括圖片、表格、參考文獻，不可超過 15 頁。全文文章請以 Adobe 編輯軟體建檔(PDF)，並於民國 104 年 4 月 19 日 23:00 前上傳至研討會網站。

請務必將所有頁首及頁尾(含頁碼)設定全數刪除。

1.1 論文題目與作者

論文題目宜簡明，字形為 14 點新細明體、粗體，置於第一頁第一行中央。作者部分包含姓名、所屬機關、聯絡地址，字型均為 12 點新細明體，亦置中，採單行間距。

1.2 文稿

大段落之標明(Level one heading)應置於每行正中央;例如:

緒 言(18 級標楷加粗體)

中段落之標明(Level two heading)應置於每行之最左方;例如:

管理外匯之風險暴露(12 級標楷加粗體)

小段落之標明(Level three heading)應置於每行之最左方;例如:

交易暴露(11 級標楷加粗體)

其他更小段落之標明請按:

交易暴露((10 級標楷加粗體) 1. (1) a. (a) 等順序排列，內文字型均採用 10 點新細明體，採單行間距。文內所有出現之英文及數字部分請使用 Time New Roman 字體。

1.3 章節與小節標題

論文之各節標題應置於列之中央位置。小節標題則應從文稿之左緣開始。

2. 關於圖片、表格及方程式

圖片及表格可以置於文中或文章最後。

2.1 圖片

圖標題必須置於圖片下方。若圖標題僅使用一行，則必須置中，否則應靠左對齊。

2.2 表格

表標題〔表 1. XX 表〕必須置於表格上方且置中。

2.3 方程式

方程式應於上下個留一行空白。方程式應編號，編號靠右對齊並從(1)開始。
